PROPERTY COMMITTEE

Over the next 2 months we will be undertaking a number of reasonably large projects around the church and manse and are seeking assistance of members of St Marks Church and School to assist. The projects include:

- 1) Provision of a balustrade to the manse verandah.
- 2) Erection of a screen fence and retaining to contain the school bins.
- 3) General clean up around the church & manse grounds in preparation for the festive season.
- 4) Application has been made for a Maintenance Grant made available by the LCA (SA). If our application is successful, we hope to have some of the paving around the church repaired as well as low retaining walls at the entrance to the main driveway and the garden bed at the front entry to the main building.

Whilst we have obtained a quote for the path repairs personnel from both the congregation and school are needed to carry out the other work. Various tools and equipment will be also required, ranging from metal bench saw, impact and normal drills, garden tools, saw bench etc. 2 'working bees' are scheduled for Sat Oct 20th - Manse balustrade, Nov 17th – General cleanup and school bin enclosure.

A sign up list will be on the notice board for you to volunteer your time and/or equipment. Any assistance in these areas would really be appreciated – yours in Christ Allan Todd.

St Mark's Lutheran School Council Nominations

Each year in November, the St Mark's Lutheran Church, Mt Barker elects the School Council who hold governance responsibility for St Mark's Lutheran School. One of the roles of the School Council is to provide nominations to the church's November election meeting. The school constitution sets the membership of the Council at eight councillors. Of the eight at least six members shall be members of St Mark's Lutheran church or another Lutheran Church with up to two councillors able to be practicing Christians from the school or wider community. Currently we have four councillors who will be in the second year of their term in 2019 and two councillors seeking re-election for a further two-year term.

The St Mark's School Council is currently seeking Expressions of Interest for two people to join the school council governance team. The role on School Council is voluntary and requires members to meet once monthly during the school year.

Ideally applicants will have experience in one of the following areas: Finance, legal and compliance frameworks, strategic thinking, problem solving and business acumen, marketing and communications, as this knowledge and experience will complement the current range of abilities within the Council as we plan for our role in a changing Mt Barker landscape. Due to the current composition of the School Council we require that the applicants are a member of St Mark's Lutheran Church, Mt Barker or a member of another Lutheran Church.

Any interested community members who are members of the Lutheran Church are invited to contact the School Council Chairperson, Bev Gogel by either phoning 0422 535 331 or leaving a message at the school front office to receive further details on the nominations process. Nominations will need to be received by Thursday, 11th October.
