COVID 19 WORSHIP GUIDELINES

We are aware of changes to government guidelines regarding places of worship. While we are not planning to implement any immediate changes at St Marks this will allow some flexibility regarding the number of people who can be seated in the church. Please continue to follow the directions of the ushers.

- On entry please register using either the QR code or written attendance sheet.
- Please observe signage on entry pertaining to your current health status, the 1.5 metre distancing rule and the need for regular hand washing and sanitiser.
- Entry to the church plant for Worship will be available through the doors into the Link on the eastern side or through the door into the Church front office / Hall on the western side. Only worshippers with mobility issues will be able to enter through the main foyer door on the western side.
- Please wait for direction from the ushers before being seated and fill seats from the front
- Communion is continuous with Pastor serving and assistants, no Common Cup. We ask that you follow the instructions from the Covid Marshalls and Ushers
- At the completion of the service, we ask that you remain seated until directed to exit by an usher, starting from the back, to avoid congestion.
