'Do you see me?' John 20:19-31 (NIV) 25 So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But (Thomas) said to them, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe.

1 Afterward Jesus appeared again to his disciples, by the Sea of Galilee. It happened this way: ... 4 Early in the morning, Jesus stood on the shore, but the disciples did not realize that it was Jesus. 'Do you see me?' John 21:1-14 (NIV) Jesus and the Miraculous Catch of Fish

6 (Jesus) said, "Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some." When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish. 7 Then the disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" 'Do you see me?' 12 Jesus said to them, "Come and have breakfast." None of the disciples dared ask him, "Who are you?" They knew it was the Lord. 'Do you see me?' John 20:19-31 (NIV)

After his resurrection, Jesus sometimes:

- Allowed himself to be seen promptly,
- Allowed himself to be seen eventually,
- Did not allow himself to be seen.


