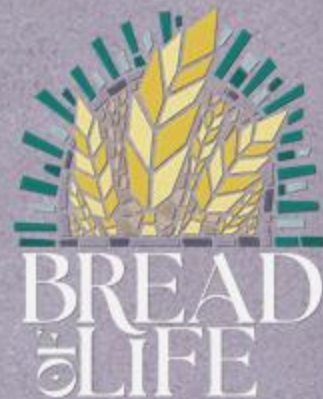

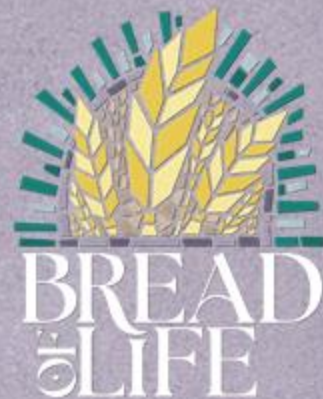

and was passing through.



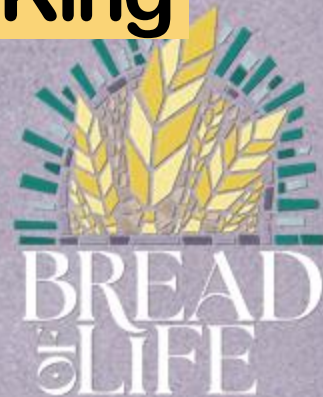

he was **short** he could not see over the crowd.



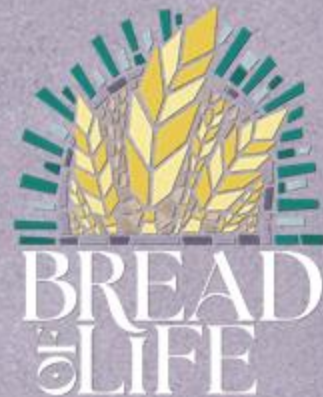

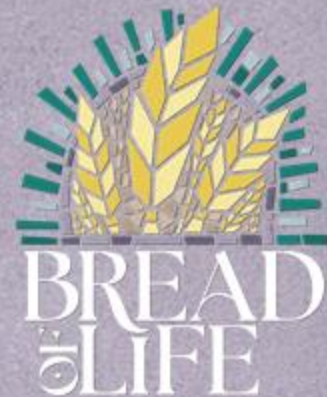
3 He **wanted to see** who Jesus was, but because he was short he could not see over the crowd.

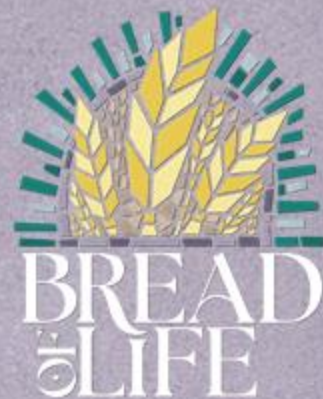

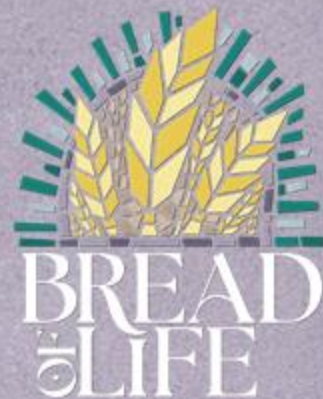

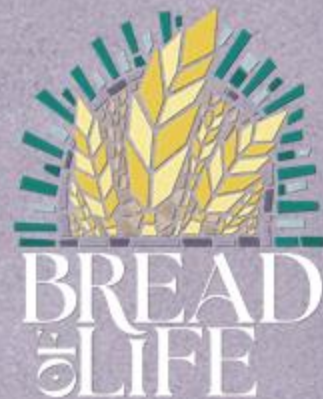

“to be a guest in your home today!”



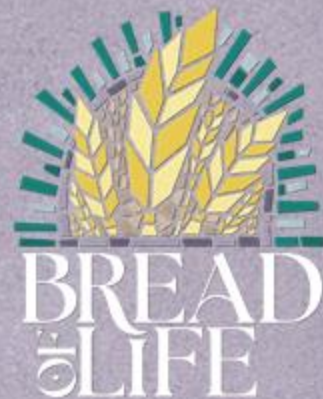

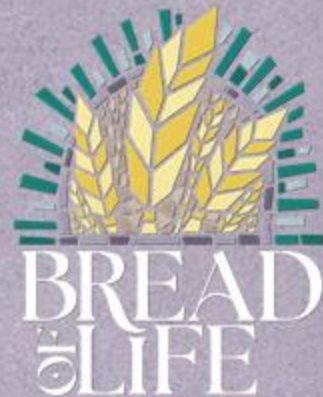
Tax Collectors in Luke:

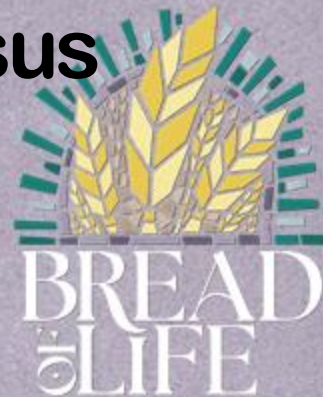
Luke 19:1-10 (NIV)

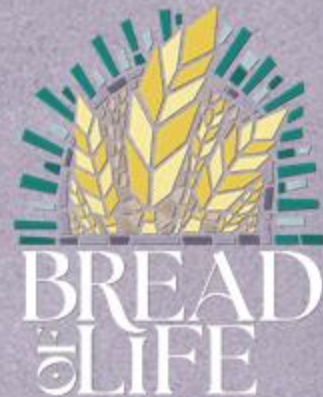

The Parable of the Pharisee and the **Tax Collector**

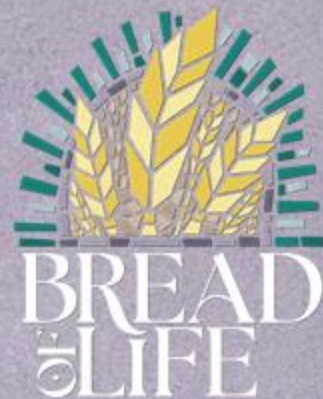
14 “I tell you that this man, rather than the other, went home justified before God.”

I will pay back four times the amount.”



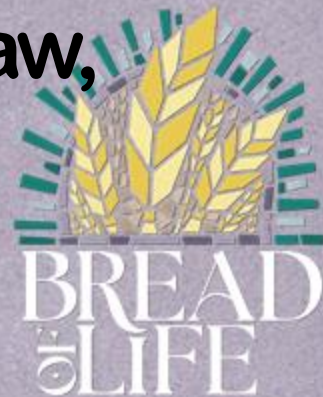

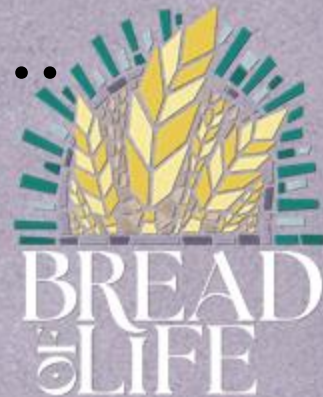

when he was being tested ...



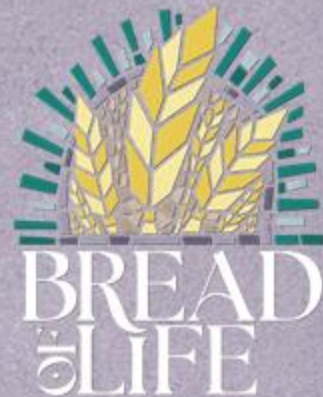

7 Know then that it is **those of faith** who are the **sons of Abraham.**

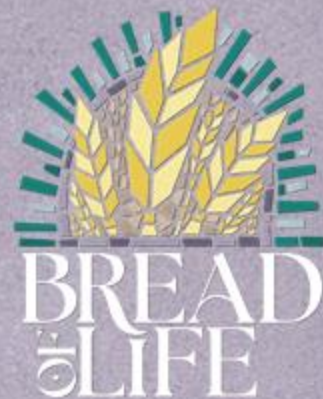


# Bread for Community

10 For the Son of Man came to seek and to save **the lost.**”



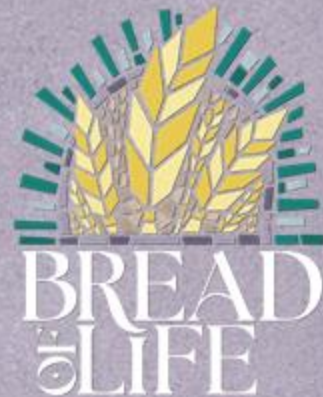
# Bread for Community
