


Sermon

Luke 19:42

'If you only knew today what is needed for peace!'



Luke 19:28-44 (GNT)

29 As (Jesus) came near Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, he sent two disciples ahead 30 with these instructions: "Go to the village there ahead of you; as you go in, you will find a colt tied up that has never been ridden. Untie it and bring it here. 35 ... they took the colt to Jesus. Then they threw their cloaks over the animal and helped Jesus get on.

Luke 19:28-44 (GNT)

36 As he rode on, people spread their cloaks on the road. 37 ... the large crowd of his disciples began to thank God and praise him in loud voices for all the great things that they had seen: 38 "God bless the king who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory to God!"

39 Then some of the Pharisees in the crowd spoke to Jesus. "Teacher," they said, "command your disciples to be quiet!"
40 Jesus answered,
"I tell you that if they keep quiet, the stones themselves will start shouting."

Australian Statistics

More than two in five Australians (42.9%) aged 16–85 years have experienced a mental disorder in their lifetime, with one in five Australians (21.5%) experiencing a mental disorder in the previous 12 months.

Australian Statistics

Anxiety was the most common group of mental disorders in 2020–2022.

More than one in six Australians (17.2%) had an anxiety disorder such as social phobia or post-traumatic stress disorder in the previous 12 months.

Australian Statistics

7.5% of people had an affective disorder such as depression, while 3.3% had a substance use disorder.

Australian Statistics

Data also showed that around
1.1 million (38.8%) young adults
aged 16–24 years experienced a mental
disorder in the previous 12 months.

Australian Statistics

Almost half of young females (45.5%) and one third of young males (32.4%) aged 16–24 years had a mental disorder in this period, with anxiety disorders being the most common.

Australian Statistics

Nearly three in five people (58.7%) who identified as gay, lesbian, or bisexual, or who used a different term to describe their sexual orientation, had a mental disorder in the previous 12 months.

One in five people (19.9%) who identified as heterosexual had a mental disorder in the same period.
